Care and Maintenance

Please read carefully

Congratulations: You have selected the most durable refinishing system available in the Country. Glas-Tech 9000 has been used in over 4 million successful applications nationwide, and by following the guidelines listed below, you will be assured many years of trouble free service. **Please DO NOT** use this surface for 24 hours (at room temperature). Although the refinished surface can be put back into full use after this time, the surface will actually require up to 90 days to completely cure. Please observe the following:

1. During the refinishing process, special masking tape was used, which will protect other surfaces during the drying and curing, but which can be easily removed by you. Remove this masking after the initial downtime, but within 1 week after the designated downtime. Care should be taken when removing the masking from the wallpaper, or painted surfaces, so remove the masking slowly and carefully.
2. Clean the finish regularly with soap and a sponge (this is called surface conditioning).

PLEASE NOTE: All newly refinished surfaces will have some surface dust, which will have settled into the new surface. Do not be alarmed; because the surface is still within its long-term cure period, normal use and regular cleaning will remove all minor surface dust marks.

3. When removing the masking from around the drain area, be careful not to break the seal around the drain shoe. Any glaze, which is left on the surface of the drain shoe, can be carefully removed with a razor blade or knife.

4. DO NOT lay soap, bottles, or any other objects on the finished surface for the first 4 months.

5. Be sure that your faucets taps are dry and not dripping after using the fixture, and be sure to towel dry the refinished surface after each use.

Cleaning

Do not use Soft scrub, cleanser, bleach, Comet, Ajax, degreasers, vinegar or any other abrasive cleansers.

We recommend Simple green, Lysol cleaner, dish soap, baby shampoo or cleaners approved for use on acrylic surfaces.

LONG TERM CARE

1. **Do not** use any abrasive scrubbing pads such as Scotchbrite™ or any similar scrubbing pad, as this will scratch the new surface. **Stay away from acid and bleaching cleaners. This will void the guarantee.**
2. **Do not** drop sharp or heavy object on the finish, which may cause it to chip. Please contact All About Kitchens and Baths if this should occur. Failure to contact us in a timely matter will void the guarantee.
3. Faucets must be properly maintained by the owner and user, to protect the new surface. Leaky faucets will erode the new finish, causing it to crack and wear out prematurely, and voiding the guarantee.
4. Destruction of the finish may occur through improper use of acid bearing compounds, such as drain openers, bleach products or tile grout cleaners. All chemicals must be kept away from the finish. These chemicals include, but are not limited to, cosmetics, hair dyes, and perfumes, which may stain or otherwise mar the finish. Use of these chemicals would be considered neglect and void the guarantee.
5. **Do not** use a rubber bath mat. Most mats will produce a reaction with the new surface when subjected to hot water. All About Kitchens and Baths carries a full line of Sure-Step Permanent Safety Mats, which will give years of trouble-free service. These mats are guaranteed.
6. Remember, if you treat your new surface with respect, clean it regularly, and follow the above guidelines, your fixture will stay shiny and bright, and give you many years of trouble free service.
